COURSE POLICIES & PROCEDURES

1. **ATTENDANCE** – As part of the curriculum, attendance at webinars, zoom meetings and live weekend sessions is mandatory to complete the course. Make-up sessions are available in emergency situations only. For details see "Unavoidable Absences" below.

Sign-in: Sign in time is within ½ hour of the start of class (both webinar and live)

Sign-out: Sign out time is the last ½ hour of the day. If you leave early without notification, it will be assumed you did not attend class that day.

- 2. **GROUP ASSIGNMENT** (Weekends 3 & 4 only) You will be given a Name Tag with a Group Color and Number. Your group color and number are your ticket into the correct clinical session and treatment table.
- 3. **ONLINE COURSE WORK** It is imperative that you keep up with the online course work (reading, lectures, video demonstrations and tests) on a weekly basis. It is important that you discipline yourself to carve out at least 6 hours from your busy schedules each week in order to view the lectures, take the tests and fill out the evaluation forms in a timely manner. Keeping up with the course material is essential, as each week of lectures you miss accumulates and can quickly become overwhelming. Remember, missing one week of lectures will mean that the following week you somehow have to find 12 hours of time to keep up. If you do not, this will adversely affect your weekend live hands-on practice experience and can hinder your learning and the progress of the classmates in your group. As the year progresses, the clinical groups will be sorted based on our assessment of your knowledge and skills so that a student who is behind does not impair the learning of those students who have kept up.
- 4. **ONLINE Quizzes** Scored quizzes are associated with all web-based lectures. You will have 15 days from the posting date on the course website to complete the online tests. After that period, the quizzes associated with each lecture will no longer be accessible and cannot be taken late. There are no acceptable excuses for failure to take the quizzes: quizzes cannot be re-posted. The online quizzes, together with the online evaluation forms (see below), are the only way to assess your participation in the course and are required to earn the CME Certificate and the diploma at the end of the program. In order to graduate from the course, you have to score at least a 75% average on your quiz scores. No exceptions will be made to this rule. In past years, there have been students, much to our regret and despite

frequent counseling about the importance of taking the self- assessment quizzes, who have not earned a CME certificate. DON'T LET THIS HAPPEN TO YOU!

- 5. **ONLINE EVALUATION FORMS** In addition to the scored quizzes, filling in the online evaluation surveys is mandatory for all students. Online evaluation surveys are associated with each lesson (web based AND weekend sessions). Completion of the evaluations forms is a requirement to obtain CME credit.
- 6. **DISCUSSION FORUM** During the year, active student participation and questions are encouraged. There is a Student Forum that allows you to ask questions about the didactic material you have viewed and any other acupuncture related question you may have. The purpose of the forum is to exchange opinions and clinical information and to allow others to also view your questions, so everyone gains from the information provided.
- 7. **CLINICAL SESSIONS** After each clinical session, all groups are expected to clean up their tables and dispose of any stray needles on the floor. Please be mindful to keep treatment areas clean and sanitary. All needles (AND ONLY NEEDLES!) must go in biohazard containers at all times.
- 8. **TREATMENT SESSIONS** As part of the course, please remember that you will periodically be the volunteer receiving acupuncture. Please wear loose baggy clothing on the weekends scrubs are great! It is mandatory that each student participate as an acupuncture volunteer, during the course, as this is an essential part of the learning process.
- 9. **PATIENTS** As part of the course, local physicians are strongly requested to bring their own patients, friends and family members to receive acupuncture as volunteers during the weekend sessions. This is a great opportunity to receive invaluable input on how to treat your own challenging patients or family members. This will be an integral part of your learning experience.
- 10. **EMAIL ADDRESS** Please note that the email address that you have provided at the time of registration will be the primary means of communication throughout the course. SHOULD YOU CHANGE YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS notify the course administration as soon as possible.

11. **REFUND POLICY**:

a. Integrated Structural Acupuncture course: You may cancel your registration up to four weeks before the start of the course. A handling fee of \$250 is deducted for cancellation. No refund will be issued should cancellation occur less than four weeks prior to the course. "No shows" and "drop-outs" are subject to the full course fee. To cancel your registration, the course administration must receive notice of cancellation by email at info@acumed.org no later than September 11, 2025.

- b. Early Bird Offer: If you register before August 1, 2025 and gain early access, your registration fee is no longer refundable after September 1, 2025.
- c. Skills Advancement Workshops: You may cancel your registration up to four weeks before the start of each scheduled event. No refund will be issued should cancellation occur less than four weeks prior to each scheduled event. "No shows" are subject to the full course fee. To cancel your registration, the course administration must receive notice of cancellation by email at info@acumed.org no later than four weeks prior to each scheduled event.

If this occurs, please contact the course administrator immediately. Make-up sessions are available and are required to obtain your CME certificate. If you miss 3 live sessions, regardless of the reason, you will not be awarded a CME certificate at the end of the year. Make-up for the Webinar sessions will be held via a Zoom Meeting (date TBD).
